About Us

Massaro Community Farm is a non-profit, certified organic farm with ~10 acres in cultivation, located in Woodbridge, CT, 10 minutes west of New Haven. 2017 will be our eighth year of production, growing over 50 types of vegetables and flowers. Massaro Farm CSA operates a 200-member CSA, sells to local restaurants and at three farmers' markets. We donate fresh produce weekly to hunger relief organizations and offer on-farm educational programs and events throughout the year. Find out more about us at www.massarofarm.org.

Job Description

Massaro Farm CSA seeks Summer Farm Crew members for 2017, from May 15 through August 25. Applicants should have high energy for and an interest in sustainable agriculture. Summer Farm Crew will be involved in all aspects of the farm operation including but not limited to:

- Harvesting, washing and packing produce for CSA, markets and restaurants
- Greenhouse work – filling and seeding trays
- Field and high tunnel work – transplanting, weeding, pruning, irrigating, installing/removing trellises, plastic mulches and row covers

Work Schedule

Our typical schedule is Monday-Friday, 7:30-4:30, with an hour break for lunch. There are some opportunities to work on weekends at the farmers' market, at on-farm events, and in the evenings on the farm at CSA distribution (2:30-6:30 Tuesdays and Fridays).

Expectations and Qualifications

Previous work on vegetable farms is a plus, but is not necessary. A strong work ethic and the ability to work collaboratively with others are essential. Our farm is part of the community, so we strive to create an open, positive and fun work environment that makes the farm welcoming to all visitors. *Must commit to the full summer season, though exact start and end dates can be slightly adjusted.*

- Willing to work outdoors in variable weather conditions
- Able to lift 50 pounds
- Dependable, punctual, self-motivated, open to learning
- Experience working both independently and as part of a team
- Comfortable interacting with community members and farm visitors
