

Lobelia cardinalis • Cardinal flower

PLANT CHARACTERISTICS: bright red blooms. H= 3-6' Spread 1-2'

DESIRED SITE LOCATION & SPACING:

- full sun to partial sun
- moist wet soil
- drought tolerance = medium
- 10" between plants and rows (recommended spacing (6-16")

ECOLOGICAL BENEFITS:

- Wildlife: attracts hummingbirds
- Conspicuous Flowers: yes
- Attracts: butterflies, hummingbirds and birds
- Nectar Source: yes



Seed Stratification
Seed-Sow to Finished Plug

cool and moist, minimum of 60 days February to mid-May (14 weeks)

Outplanting

late May

Flowering Period

late July - early September

SOWING & SEED DEPTH:

- Seeds are VERY small and need light for germination. Surface sow.

SEED COLLECTION:

- mid-October November
- harvest stalk with seed pods leaving main stems for overwintering insects
- harvest pod when plump, dark brown, paper-dry and just as they begin to open at the top
- mature seeds are yellowish
- carefully break pod open and pour seed out onto a white collection sheet

PESTS & DISEASE: none of note
