

Achillea millefolium • common yarrow

PLANT CHARACTERISTICS: small white blooms. H= 1-2' Spread 1-2'

DESIRED SITE LOCATION & SPACING:

- full sun to partial shade
- dry to medium
- drought tolerance = high
- 10" between plants and rows (recommended spacing (6-16")

ECOLOGICAL BENEFITS:

- Wildlife: attracts bees
- Conspicuous Flowers: yes
- Attracts: of special value to native bees
- Nectar Source: yes



Seed Stratification cool and moist, minimum of 30 days Seed-Sow to Finished Plug February to mid-May (14 weeks)

Outplanting late May

Flowering Period late July - early September

SOWING & SEED DEPTH:

- Sow 3 seeds per cell; cover with media equal to thickness of the seed.

SEED COLLECTION:

- mid-October November
- harvest entire inflorescence leaving remainder of stems for overwintering insects
- harvest when brown, straw-like and beginning to spread open
- mature seeds are light tan
- seeds can be shaken out onto a white collection paper

PESTS & DISEASE: none of note
