River Ridge Farm is a four-season, diversified fruit, vegetable, and cut flower farm entering its 7th year of production. We farm across three locations, with approximately one acre under greenhouse cultivation and about 35 acres in production. As a low-till, organic operation, we are deeply committed to soil health and environmental well-being.

We are a production-driven farm business with many moving parts—field production, greenhouse growing, harvest, wash/pack, farmers markets, two year-round farm stores, an ice cream shop, and a bakery—all of which must work together smoothly. Our crew is close-knit, hardworking, and motivated. We move fast, solve problems in real time, and rely on each other to keep things running.

The work is physical, full, and sometimes chaotic, especially during peak season. Staying calm, adaptable, and focused when things get busy is essential. At the same time, this is a fun, collaborative place to work: we laugh, we learn, and we take pride in doing meaningful work together. If you enjoy being part of a team that works hard, stays grounded under pressure, and finishes the day tired but proud, we'd love to hear from you.
